

Pupil Premium and Key Stage 2 SATS results 2012.

For the current financial year, the school receives £16 800 to support disadvantaged pupils. This money is spent on a variety of initiatives which gives these pupils the best possible chance to make good progress. This money has been supporting: one to one and small group intervention work; booster sessions; KLC (Kid's Learning Club – homework support); and has supported the school in having learning support staff in every year group in the school. In addition, this money has been spent on the ingredient cost of providing Free School Meals and has supported children taking part in school trips as needed.

Disadvantaged pupils are monitored carefully and appropriate support is put in place where appropriate. Feedback from parents and end of Key Stage 2 data shows good outcomes for these pupils at Binfield C.E. Primary School (V.A).
