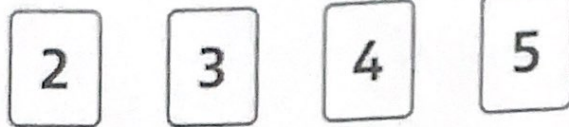




- 5 a) Use each card once to create four different calculations. Find the answer to each calculation.



$$2.3 \times 4.5 = 103.5$$

$$2.3 \times 5.4 = 124.2$$

$$3.2 \times 4.5 = 144$$

$$4.3 \times 2.5 = 107.5$$

You may have different combinations

- b) What is the difference between the largest and the smallest product you can make using these cards?

$2.5 \times 3.4 = 8.5$	139.6	Smallest = 8.4 (2.4×3.5 or 3.5×2.4)
$4.5 \times 2.3 = 103.5$		
$4.2 \times 3.5 = 147$		Largest = 223.6 (4.3×5.2 or 5.2×4.3)
$5.2 \times 4.3 = 223.6$
