

Mysterious Disappearance of Beach Boy

Boy still missing after a trip to the beach.

Harry Harrison (11) has been reported missing after visiting his local beach on Thursday 28th May. His mother, Valerie Harrison, contacted police after Harry failed to return home. A major search has been organised in a bid to establish what has happened to Harry.

Harry was last seen at approximately 11:40am by a local dog walker. Susie Davies (40) told us, "I was playing with Bruno, my dog, on the beach. He just loves to chase balls and play in the water. Anyway, I noticed this lad, matching Harry's description, lying in the sand. He looked like he was asleep. After a little while, I decided to walk further along the beach and I noticed he had gone. I didn't see him leave though. However, something unusual did happen, now that I think about it. It suddenly went

really dark, like the sun had gone behind a cloud, except there weren't any clouds. There was also this really strange, irritating noise. It only lasted a little while and then it was gone. I do hope they find him."

Chief Superintendent Sarah Morris (56) stated, "We have only been able to speak to one witness so far, the beach appeared to be very quiet on the day in question. We will continue our search efforts and we are also liaising closely with the Coastguard. At present, we have no solid leads to follow."

So, Police appear to be baffled by this case and concern for Harry is growing.
