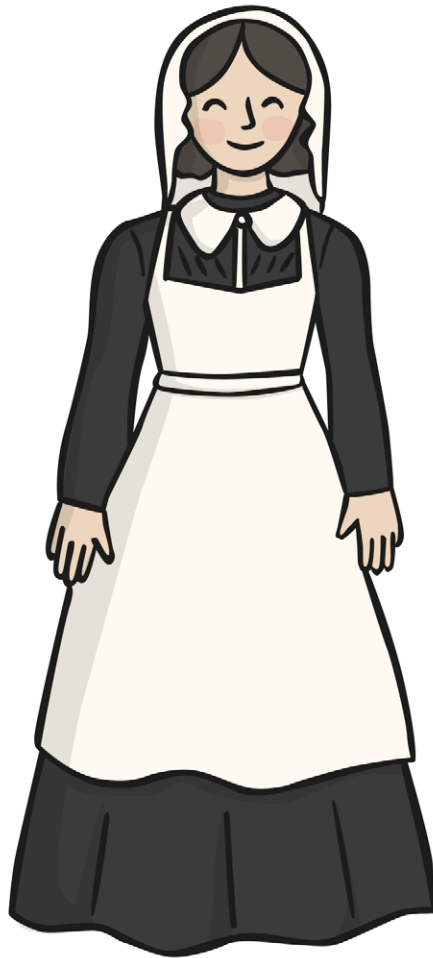
Florence felt God call

better care in hospitals.



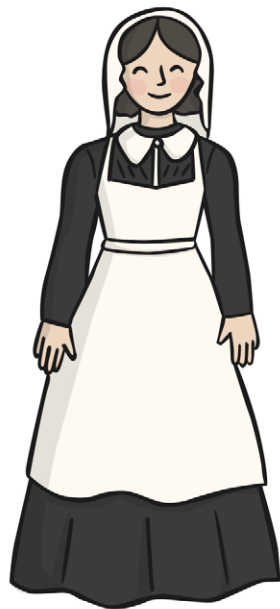

broke out.



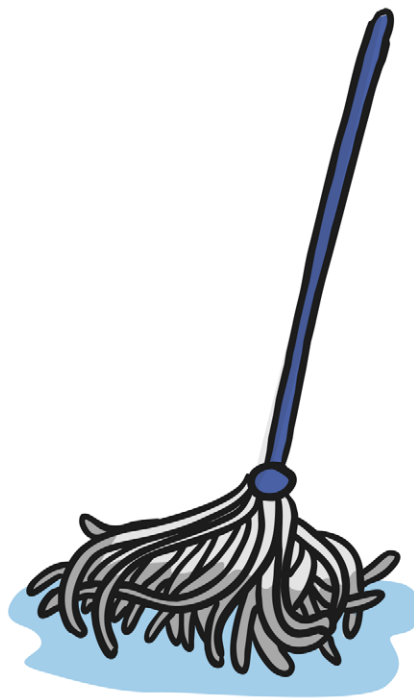

for wounded soldiers.



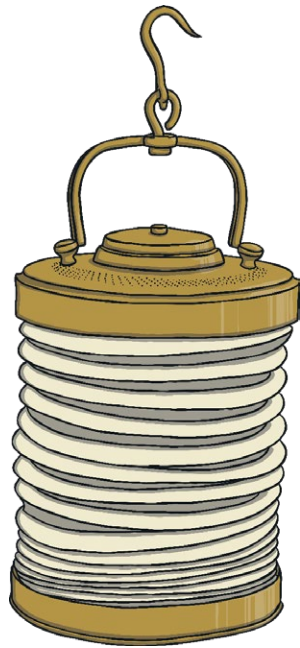

People gave lots of money to the Nightingale Fund for the training of nurses.



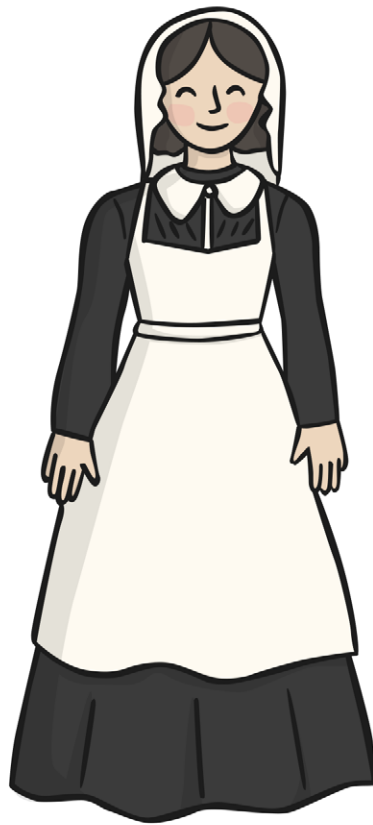

The Crimean War ended.



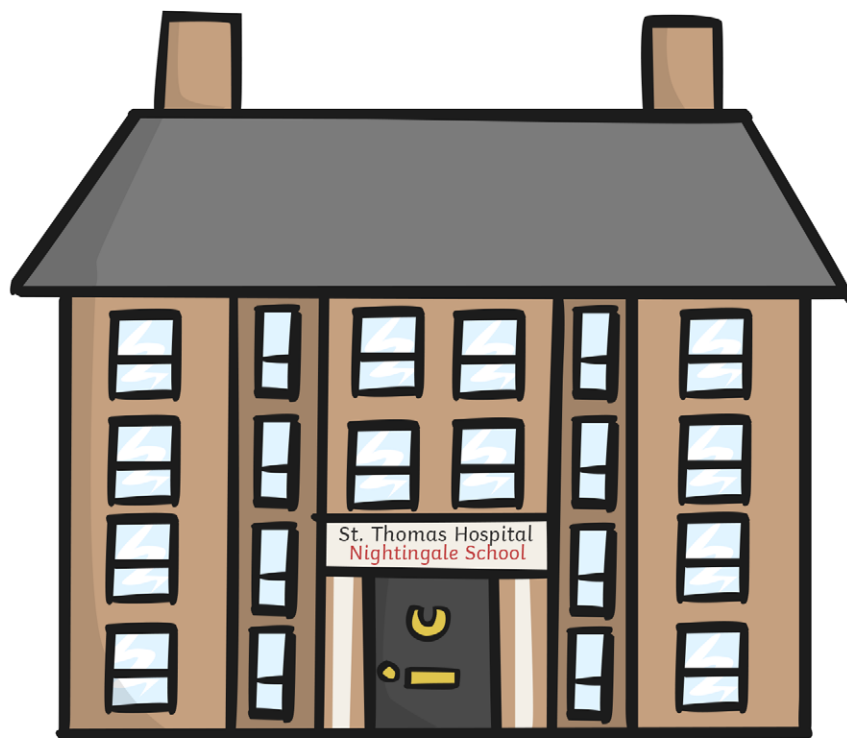
