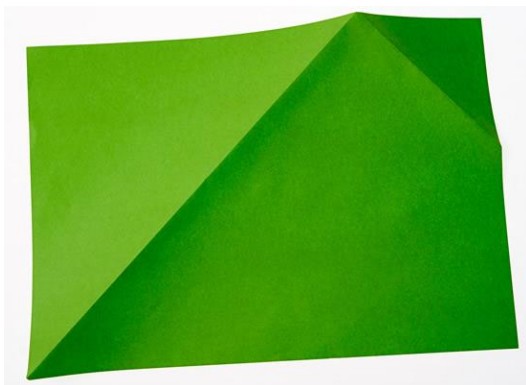
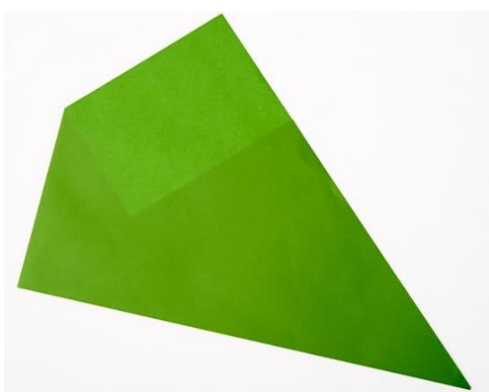


D.T. Activity 1.6.20 – Rainbow window stars



If you make these folds in a piece of A4 paper, it will make a quadrilateral – which one?

That's right – a kite.



It should look like this:

You will need:

A piece of A4 paper in red, an orange piece, a yellow piece, a green piece, a blue piece, a purple piece and a pink piece (if you don't have coloured paper, you could colour some...)

Make them all into kite shapes.



Next, we have to glue them together. Use tiny blobs of glue (a glue stick would be even better!)

Start with your first colour and add glue into the lower right hand corner. The next piece will line up against the centre fold and proceed to glue the two together.



Continue with this process until all eight pieces are used. You have now made your very own rainbow paper window star! For a chance to make smaller stars, simply cut the pieces of paper in half.

I wonder if you could hang your stars in your windows to raise a smile on the faces of passers-by...
