

# Santa and His Flying Sleigh

## Supplies

- 2 pieces of coloured card (A3)
- Cotton wool
- Santa and Reindeer Template
- Felt-tip pens and/or pencil crayons
- White glue



- Lolly sticks
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Scissors



1 In preparation, choose some coloured card for your background scene and one for your foreground scene. Make sure that they are both placed in a landscape orientation. Also, print out the Santa and reindeer pictures onto white card.



5 You can now make the stick puppets! We have used the coloured version but you may want to colour in blank versions using felt-tip pens or pencil crayons. Then, carefully cut out each picture.



2 Use the pencil to draw a scene which goes right along the bottom of the foreground card. Then, use scissors to cut along it. You can discard the top bit.



6 Stick each picture onto a lolly stick, using white glue and leave to dry.



3 Use glue to stick the foreground scene onto the bottom of the background card. Then, decorate the foreground scene by gluing on pieces of cotton wool.



7 Once all parts are dry, carefully push the stick puppets through the slit in the card. This should create a scene of Santa flying through the sky with his reindeer!



4 Next, use a ruler to draw a line diagonally across the width of the card. The line needs to start higher on the left-hand side and slant down. The line also needs to finish around 5cm away from either end of the card. Use scissors to carefully cut along the line (you may need an adult to help with this).

# Santa and His Flying Sleigh



## Supplies

- 2 pieces of coloured card (A3)

- Lolly sticks
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Scissors





- Step 1.** In preparation, choose some coloured card for your background scene and one for your foreground scene. Make sure that they are both placed in a landscape orientation. Also, print out the Santa and reindeer pictures onto white card.



- Step 2.** Use the pencil to draw a scene which goes right along the bottom of the foreground card. Then, use scissors to cut along it. You can discard the top bit.



**Step 3.** Use glue to stick the foreground scene onto the bottom of the background card. Then, decorate the foreground scene by gluing on pieces of cotton wool.

**Step 4.**

Next, use a ruler to draw a line diagonally across the width of the card. The line needs to start higher on the left-hand side and slant down. The line also needs to finish around 5cm away from either end of the card. Use scissors to carefully cut along the line (you may need an adult to help with this).



**Step 5.** You can now make the stick puppets! We have used the coloured version but you may want to colour in blank versions using felt-tip pens or pencil crayons. Then, carefully cut out each picture.



**Step 6.** Stick each picture onto a lolly stick, using white glue and leave to dry.



- Step 7.** Once all parts are dry, carefully push the stick puppets through the slit in the card. This should create a scene of Santa flying through the sky with his reindeer!
