# Roy Lichtenstein

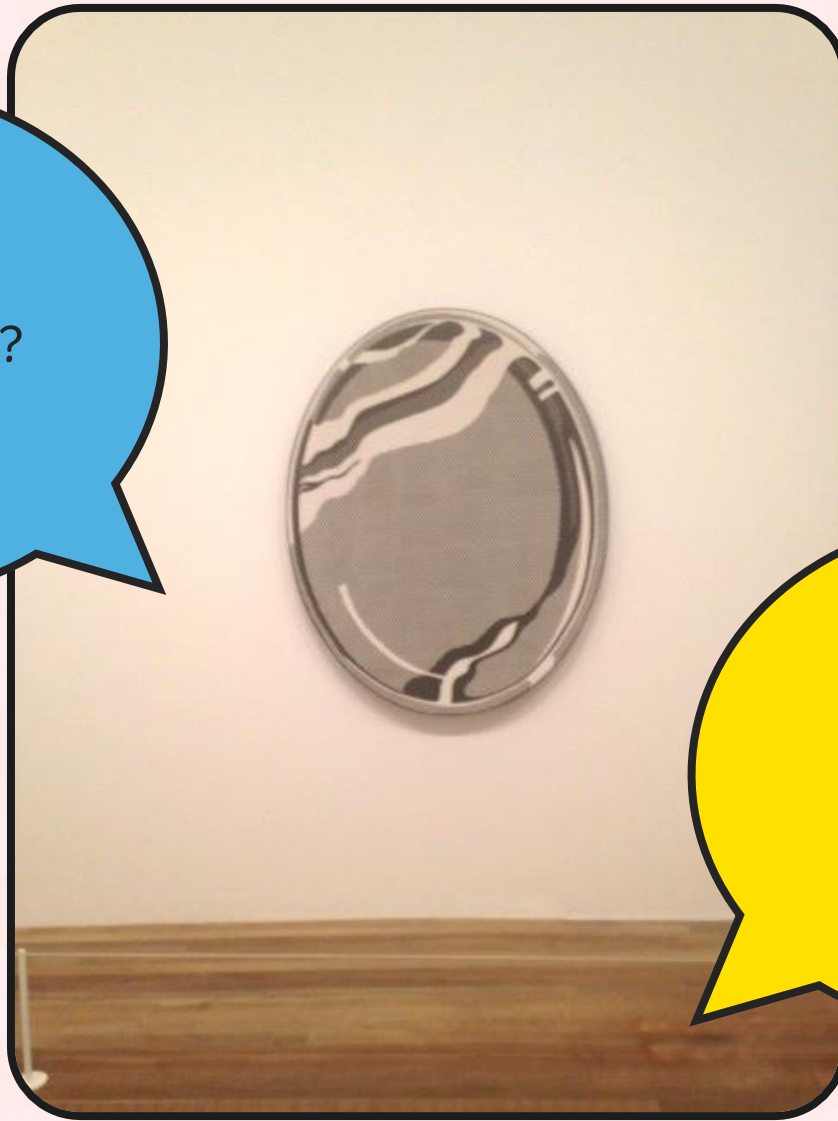
Roy Lichtenstein was born in 1923 in America.

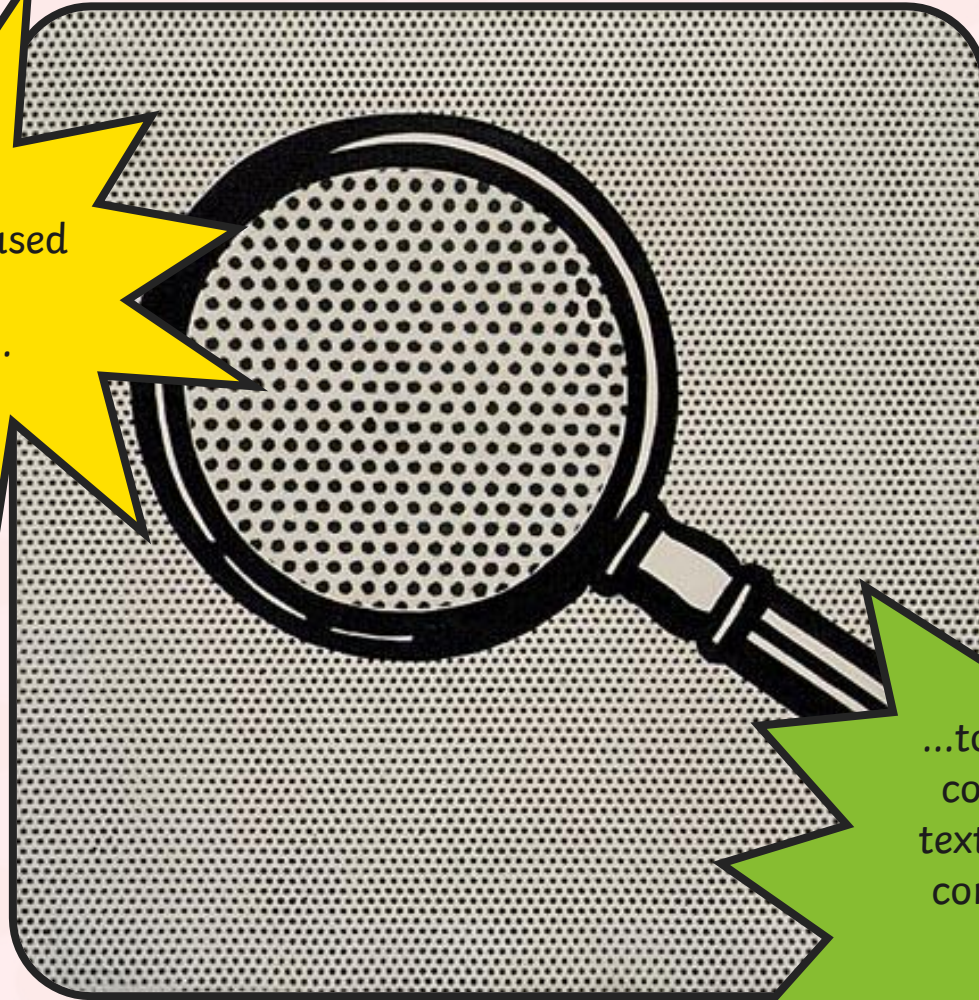
Lichtenstein

Lichtenstein is very popular today.



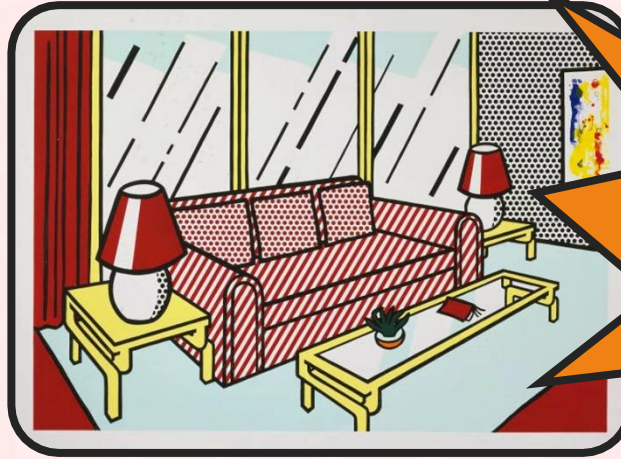
One of his paintings sold for more than 55 million dollars in 2013.

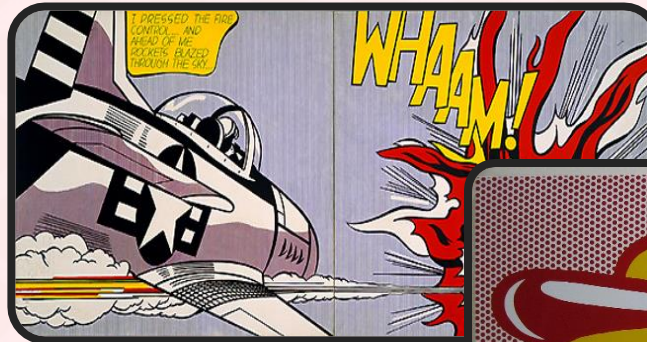
