

Key vocabulary	Definitions
Digital media	Any media that are encoded in machine-readable formats. Digital media refers to any kind of information broadcast to us through a screen. This information might be found on websites or in applications, software packages, video games, and more. Digital media can be created, viewed, distributed, modified and preserved on digital electronics devices.
Image	A digital image is an image composed of picture elements, also known as pixels.
Video	the recording, reproducing, or broadcasting of moving visual images.
Sound	Digital audio is a representation of sound recorded in, or converted into, digital form. In digital audio, the sound wave of the audio signal is encoded as numerical samples in a continuous sequence.
Interview	a meeting of people face to face, especially for consultation.

Editing Techniques

 <p>When we only need a part of a photograph, we can crop the image. We also enlarge and reduce the parts that we need.</p>	 <p>We can make more than one of an image by copying it. We can also rotate and flip images to create different effects.</p>
 <p>Photograph editing programs often have filters. These can change the colours in a photograph. Different colours can give us different feelings.</p>	 <p>When the lighting of the photograph is not quite right, we can change the brightness of the photograph.</p>
 <p>We can add and remove parts of a photograph by using cut, copy and paste tools.</p>	 <p>We can change the contrast of photographs, making the subjects clear.</p>
