Print	A print is an impression made by any method involving transfer from one surface to another.
Repeating pattern	
Nature print	Printing using plants, animals, rocks and other natural materials. 
Press, roll, rub and stamp	Different techniques for printing in art. 
Lino Print	A design is cut into the lino surface with a cutter, the lino sheet is inked with a roller, and then impressed onto paper, fabric, or any other surface.

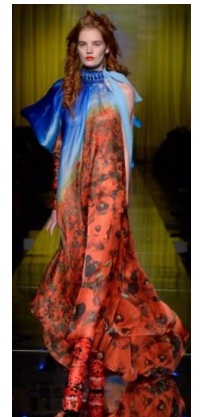
Printing
