Design	To draw an idea down that meets certain requirements.
Digital media	Using computers or cameras to create and alter designs.
Texture	The perceived surface of the art work
Line	A long, narrow mark or band. ———
Tone	Areas of lightness and darkness on an object or colour.
Colour	Primary colours are red, yellow and blue. Secondary colours are made by mixing those.
Shape	Shape and form define objects in space. Shapes have two dimensions, height and width and are usually defined by lines.

The 'Golden Carriage'. The Gold State Coach is an enclosed, eight-horse-drawn carriage used by the British Royal Family. Commissioned in 1760, it was built in the London workshops of Samuel Butler. This coach has been used at the coronation of every British monarch since George IV.
