Key vocabulary	Definition
Design	To draw an idea that meets certain requirements.
Puppet	A movable model of a person or animal.
Textile	A type of cloth or woven fabric.
Plait	A single length of hair, straw, rope, or other material made up of three or more interlaced strands.
Felt	Material produced by matting, condensing and pressing fibres together. It doesn't fray easily.
Needle	A pointed tool with a hole at the top for thread to go through. Used in sewing.
Aesthetic	The look of a product



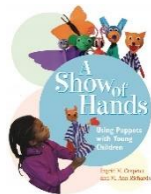
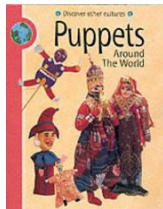
Design brief:

To design and make a hand puppet.

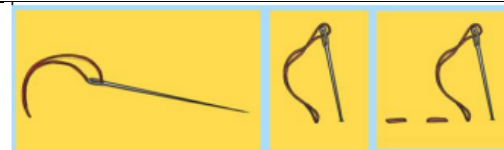
The hand puppet needs to represent an animal from Madagascar

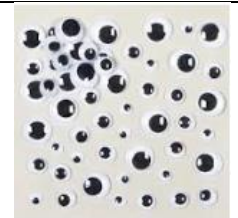
