Key vocabulary	Definition
Sculpture	Sculpture is three-dimensional art.
Clay	A stiff, sticky material that can be moulded when wet, and is dried and baked to make bricks, pottery, and ceramics.
Texture	The feel or shape of a surface; the smoothness, roughness, softness.
Materials	A range of media including; rolled up paper, straws, card and clay to create your sculpture.

Slip	Watered down clay. It is used as 'glue' to hold clay pieces together as it helps to prevent cracking.
Edouard Martinet	Insect sculptor from France.

Pulling and pinching the clay with your fingers



Carving details into the clay with tools



Smoothing out the clay with your fingers



Creating holes or hollows in the clay with tools
