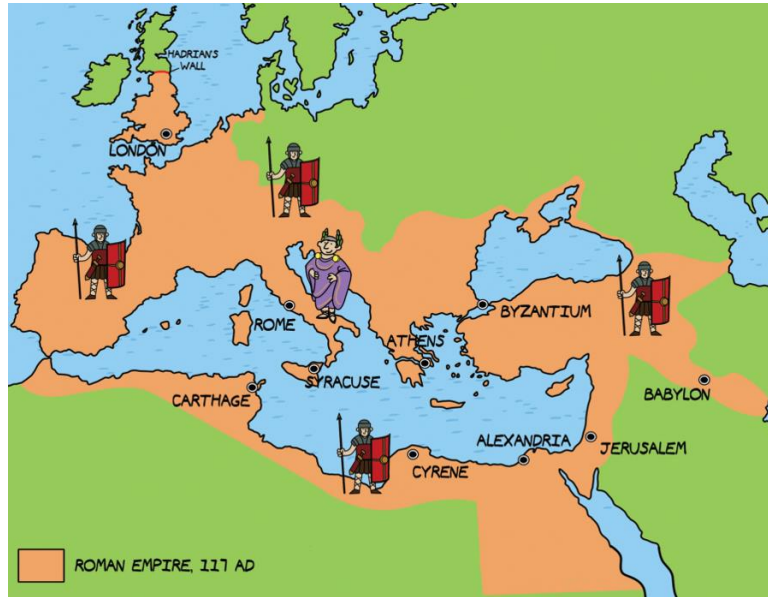
Battle – to go to war. A fight between organised armed forces.

Conquer – to overcome and take control of (a place or people) by military force

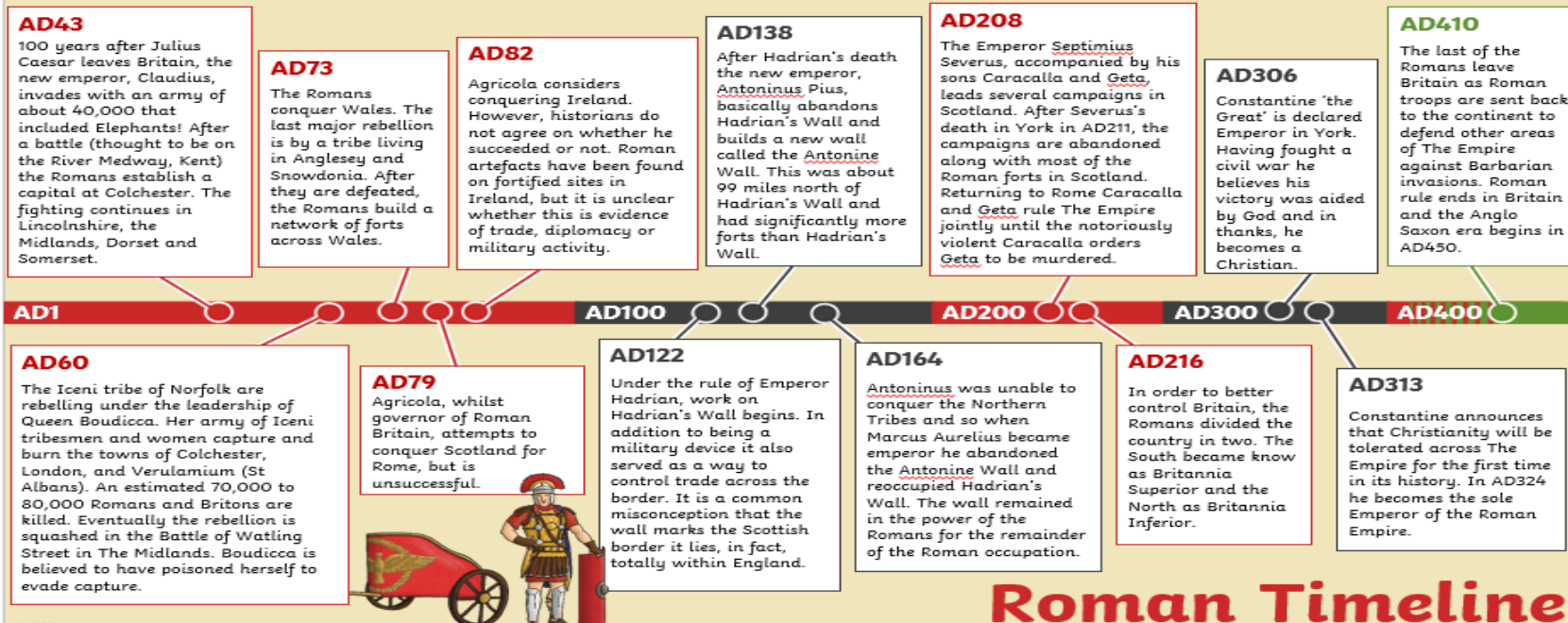
