6.1 Mini Baker Magazine – to revisit later.

6.2 Grants – Unfortunately we were not successful with the Lexicon or the Parish grants but Claire is currently following up with the Parish Council on the reasons for refusal for the Parish Grant as it has been noted that Kings Academy were awarded a parish grant towards IT recently. Katie Lewis has suggested that we apply for Persimmon Homes community grants which is drawn monthly so Claire will keep applying for this going forward. Jo reminded everyone about the importance of match funding and it was agreed we need to publicise this more widely.

6.3 PTA events transaction fees – Discussion held about best way forward re fees. Nicola raised that we could cover the annual cost (£350) by selling advertising space (e.g. £75 per spot). Kate checked back and FOBS have paid £280 in PTA events fees over 2021/2022 academic year plus some parents do cover the fees. Unanimous decision by all present to proceed with paying the annual fee to PTA events
Nicola & Jo to liaise re setting up advertising slots on PTA events and changing contract with PTA events.

7. CHAIR REPORT

7.1 Previous events overview

7.1.1 Circus : As 2022 circus was so successful, there was a unanimous vote to proceed with booking circus for 2024. It was suggested that we consider having stalls / circus skills workshops around the field to make the event last longer. This would depend on the exact deal negotiated with the circus provider.

7.1.2 Party Bye the Pitch : The glitter tattoos were very successful and we are happy to take part again if invited.

7.1.3 Sports Days : Very successful although we now have a large stock of water to use up as this was less popular on the 2nd date.

7.1.4 2nd Hand Uniform sale : new date to be set up before half term. The flash sale (any item for £1) was very successful although we have limited logo items available currently.

7.1.5 Bag2School : July sale was very successful and next date booked is 7th October (parish room will be available again on the Thursday).
