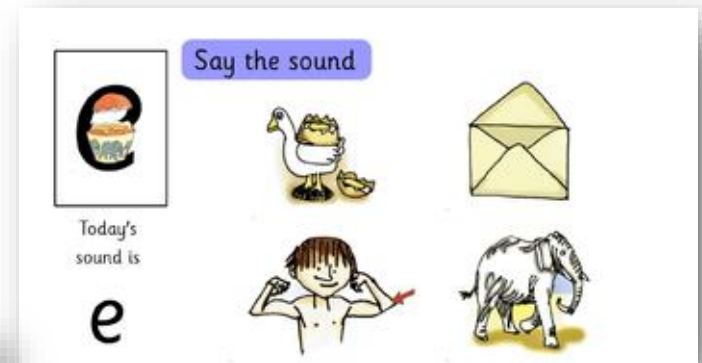


Systematic Approach

not got sip pop dad did dog

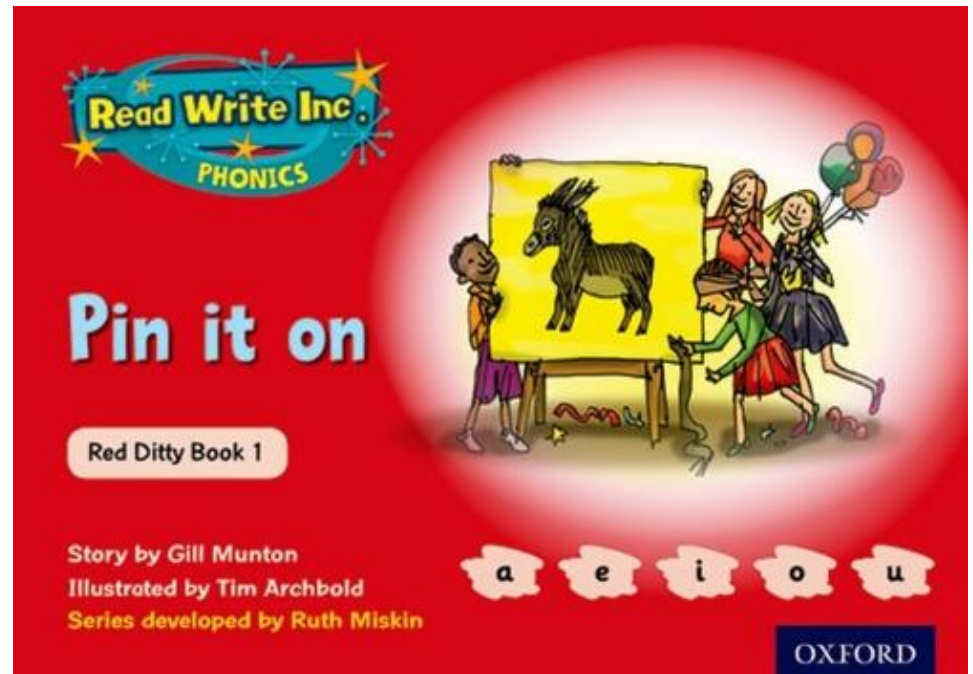
Red Words - read these words but tell your child the word if they get stuck

Pink Stage

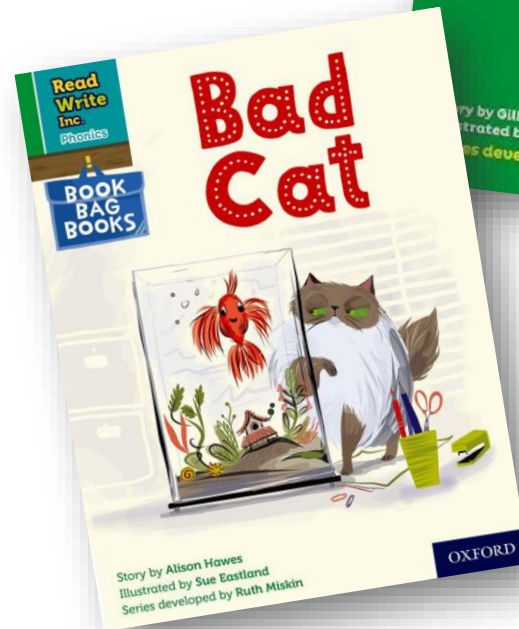

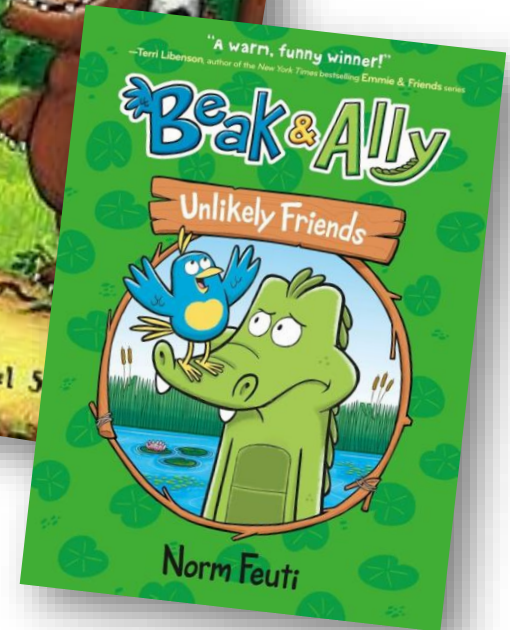

Storytime

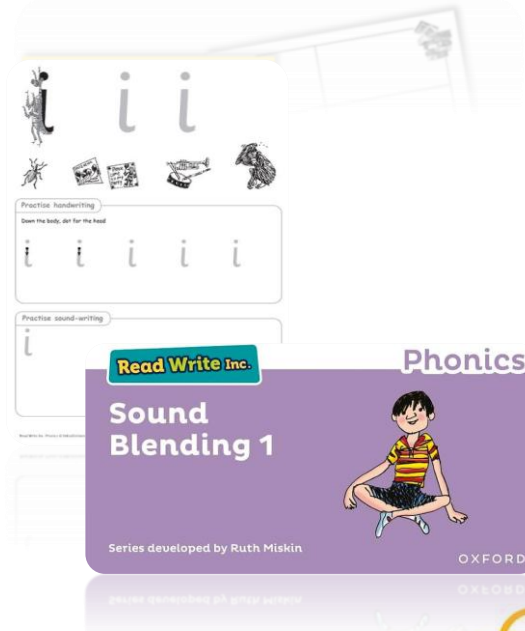
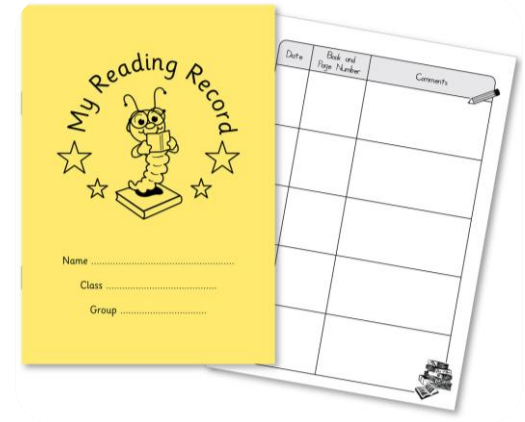
- Read **to** your children as well as hearing them read
